Pickwick Academy Trust is committed to protecting your privacy and developing technology that gives you the most powerful and safe online experience. This Statement of Privacy applies to the Pickwick Academy Trust websites and governs data collection and usage. By using the Pickwick Academy Trust websites, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Use of cookies

The Pickwick Academy Trust websites uses “cookies” to help you personalise your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalise Pickwick Academy Trust pages, or register with Pickwick Academy Trust site or services, a cookie helps Pickwick Academy Trust to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same Pickwick Academy Trust websites, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Pickwick Academy Trust features that you customised.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the Pickwick Academy Trust services or websites you visit.

Security of your personal information

Pickwick Academy Trust secures your personal information from unauthorised access, use or disclosure. Pickwick Academy Trust secures the personally identifiable information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorised access, use or disclosure. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other websites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.
